The following information was gathered from California's **Licensed Midwife Annual Reports** (LMAR) and the Center for Disease Control's **National Vital Statistics Reports**. California's Licensed Midwives primarily care for women planning out-of-hospital births. The LMAR includes all outcomes of planned births with Licensed Midwives, whether completed out-of-hospital or transferred to the hospital.








